

Internship Terms of Reference

TANZANIA

The Red Cross Red Crescent Climate Centre (RCCC) is looking for an intern based in Tanzania to work closely with the Tanzania Red Cross in carrying out an Multi-hazard Early Warning System Assessment at national and city levels. Specifically the intern will complete following tasks:

- 1. To carry out desk top research, key informant interviews and focus group discussions (where applicable) to complete the check list for at least one city in each country assigned to the intern.
- 2. To prepare a report synthesizing the findings, gaps and recommendations for improving the MHEWSA tool.
- 3. To support the other two activities under this funding, namely development of EWS Roadmap and Heat-Health Threshold(s)

Learning Objective

This internship will help build local capacities in understanding the multi hazard early warning systems and carrying out multi-stakeholder consultations to assess the gaps and capabilities at the city level.

Deliverables (tasks, output, milestones)

- 1. The completed MHEWSA check list for at least one city in the country.
- 2. Final synthesis report.

Timeline

The internship will be completed between September 15 – December 15, 2025.

Reporting

The intern will report to the RCCC regional urban advisor in Africa.

Compensation/Remuneration

This is a home-based, task-based assignment.

Compensation will be based on 450 Euro per month with 40 working hours every week. This amount will be transferred on a monthly basis.
